PRIVACY NOTICE

WorldPac Canada or Carquest Canada and affiliates (collectively, the "Company," "we," or "us") wants you to be familiar with how we collect, use, and disclose information in association with our operation of our business. This Privacy Notice describes our practices in connection with information that we collect through:

- Websites operated by us from which you are accessing this Privacy Notice (the "Websites");
- Software applications made available by us for use on or through computers and mobile or other devices (the "Apps");
- Our social media pages on third-party social media platforms (collectively, our "Social Media Pages");
- HTML-formatted email messages and other communications technologies that we send to you (collectively, our "Communications"); and
- Offline business interactions you have with us, including communications with our call centers and transactions in our stores.

Collectively, we refer to the Websites, Apps, Social Media Pages, Communications, and other online and offline business interactions as the "Services."

PERSONAL INFORMATION

"Personal Information" is information that identifies you as an individual or relates to an identifiable individual. The Services may collect Personal Information, including but not limited to:

- Name
- Postal address (including billing and shipping addresses)
- Telephone number
- Email address and other online identifiers
- Vehicle type
- Purchase and transaction history
- IP address (we may also derive your approximate location from your IP address)

- Internet and network activity information, such as browsing history, online behavior, and interactions with our Services and other websites, applications, and systems.
- Payment card data
- Resume information and other related information if you choose to apply for a job through our Careers site

Collection of Personal Information

We and our service providers on our behalf collect Personal Information in a variety of ways, including:

• Through the Services.

• We collect Personal Information through the Services, for example, when you sign up for a newsletter, respond to a survey or fill out a form, register for a product warranty, sign up for a loyalty program, create an account to access the Services, visit our stores, attend one of our events, enter into a contest or sweepstakes, place an order, provide a review, contact customer service, or make a purchase.

• From Other Sources.

• We receive your Personal Information from other sources, for example, publicly available databases.

We need to collect Personal Information to provide the requested Services to you. If you do not provide the information requested, we may not be able to provide the Services. If you disclose any Personal Information relating to other people to us or to our service providers in connection with the Services, you represent that you have the authority to do so and to permit us to use the information in accordance with this Privacy Notice.

Use of Personal Information

We and our service providers on our behalf use Personal Information for the following purposes:

• Providing the functionality of the Services and fulfilling your requests.

- To provide the Services' functionality to you, such as arranging access to your registered account and providing you with related benefits, special promotions, or customer service.
- To respond to your inquiries and fulfill your requests, when you contact us via one of our online contact forms or otherwise, for example, when you send us questions, suggestions, compliments or complaints, or when you request a quote for or other information about our Services.

- To complete your transactions, process returns and exchanges, verify your information, and provide you with related benefits, special promotions, or customer service.
- To send administrative information to you, such as changes to our terms, conditions, and policies.
- To process your job application if you apply for a job through our Careers site and to conduct applicable screening if we offer you a position.

• Providing you with our newsletter and/or other marketing materials and facilitating social sharing.

• To send you marketing related emails, SMS, mobile notifications, etc., with information about our Services, new products, and other news about our company.

Analyzing Personal Information for business reporting and providing personalized services.

- To analyze or predict our users' preferences to prepare aggregated trend reports on how our digital content is used, so we can improve our Services.
- To better understand your interests and preferences, so that we can personalize our interactions with you and provide you with information and/or offers tailored to your interests.
- To better understand your preferences so that we can deliver content via our Services that we believe will be relevant and interesting to you.

• Allowing you to participate in sweepstakes, contests, or other promotions.

- We may offer you the opportunity to participate in a sweepstakes, contests, or other promotions.
- Some of these promotions have additional rules containing information about how we
 will use and disclose your Personal Information. Please read those additional rules
 before choosing to participate.

Aggregating and/or anonymizing Personal Information.

 We may aggregate and/or anonymize Personal Information so that it will no longer be considered Personal Information. We do so to generate other data for our use, which we may use and disclose for any purpose, as it no longer identifies you or any other individual.

Accomplishing our business purposes.

- For data analysis, for example, to improve the efficiency of our Services;
- For audits, to verify that our internal processes function as intended and to address legal, regulatory, or contractual requirements;
- For fraud prevention and fraud and security monitoring purposes, for example, to detect and prevent cyberattacks or attempts to commit identity theft;
- For developing new products and services;
- For enhancing, improving, repairing, maintaining, or modifying our current products and services, as well as undertaking quality, security, and safety assurance measures;
- For identifying usage trends, for example, understanding which parts of our Services are of most interest to users;
- For determining the effectiveness of our promotional campaigns, so that we can adapt our campaigns to the needs and interests of our users; and
- For operating and expanding our business activities, for example, understanding which parts of our Services are of most interest to our users so we can focus our energies on meeting our users' interests.

Disclosure of Personal Information

We disclose Personal Information:

- To our affiliates for the purposes described in this Privacy Notice.
- To our third-party service providers, to facilitate services they provide to us.
 - These can include providers of services such as website hosting, data analysis, payment processing, order fulfillment, return authorization, fraud prevention, information technology and related infrastructure provision, customer service, or related benefits (including special promotions), email delivery, auditing, and other services.
- To third parties, to permit them to send you marketing communications, consistent with your choices.
- To third party sponsors of sweepstakes, contests, and similar promotions.
- By using the Services, you may elect to disclose Personal Information.
 - On message boards, chat, profile pages, blogs, and other services to which you are able to post information and content (including, without limitation, our Social Media

- Pages). Please note that any information you post or disclose through these services will become public and may be available to other users and the general public.
- Through your social sharing activity. When you connect your Services account to your social media account, you will share information with your friends associated with your social media account, with other users, and with your social media account provider. By doing so, you authorize us to facilitate this sharing of information, and you understand that the use of shared information will be governed by the social media provider's privacy policy.

Other Uses and Disclosures

We also use and disclose your Personal Information as necessary or appropriate, in particular when we have a legal obligation or where we are permitted by law to do so:

- To comply with applicable law and regulations.
 - This may include laws outside your country of residence.
- To cooperate with public and government authorities.
 - To respond to a request or to provide information we believe is necessary or appropriate.
 - These can include authorities outside your country of residence.
- To cooperate with law enforcement.
 - For example, when we respond to law enforcement requests and orders or provide information we believe is important.
- For other legal reasons.
 - To enforce our terms and conditions or any agreement we have entered in with you; and
 - To help protect our rights, privacy, safety or property, and/or that of our affiliates, users, you, or others; and
 - For such other purposes as are required or permitted by law, including to allow us to pursue available remedies or limit the damages that we may sustain.

In connection with a sale or business transaction.

• We may disclose your Personal Information to a third party in the event of any reorganization, merger, sale, joint venture, assignment, transfer, or other disposition

of all or any portion of our business, assets, or stock (including in connection with any bankruptcy or similar proceedings).

Collection of Other Information

We and our service providers on our behalf may collect Other Information in a variety of ways, including:

Through your browser or device.

• Certain information is collected by most browsers or automatically through your device, such as your Media Access Control (MAC) address, computer type (Windows or Mac), screen resolution, operating system name and version, device manufacturer and model, language, internet browser type and version, and the name and version of the Services (such as the App) you are using. We use this information to ensure that the Services function properly.

• Through your use of the App.

• When you download and use the App, we and our service providers may track and collect App usage data, such as the date and time the App on your device accesses our servers, your location, and what information and files have been downloaded to the App based on your device number.

Through cookies.

- Cookies are pieces of information stored directly on the computer that you are using. Cookies allow us to collect information such as browser type, time spent on the Services, pages visited, language preferences, and other traffic data. We and our service providers use the information for security purposes, to facilitate navigation, to display information more effectively, and to personalize your experience. We also gather statistical information about use of the Services in order to continually improve their design and functionality, understand how they are used, and assist us with resolving questions regarding them. Cookies further allow us to select which of our advertisements or offers are most likely to appeal to you and display them while you are on the Services. We may also use cookies or other technologies in online advertising to track responses to our ads. We do not currently respond to browser donot-track signals. Pixel tags and other similar technologies.

- Analytics. This Privacy Notice does not address, and we are not responsible for, the privacy, information, or other practices of any third parties, including any third party operating any website or service to which the Services link. The inclusion of a link on the Services does not imply endorsement of the linked site or service by us or by our affiliates. We encourage you to review all third-party privacy policies prior to using third-party websites, products, or services.

In addition, we are not responsible for the information collection, use, disclosure, or security policies or practices of other organizations, such as Facebook, Apple, Google, Microsoft, RIM, or any other app developer, app provider, social media platform provider, operating system provider, wireless service provider, or device manufacturer, including with respect to any Personal Information you disclose to other organizations through or in connection with the Apps or our Social Media Pages.

THIRD PARTY ADVERTISING

We use third-party advertising companies to serve advertisements regarding goods and services that may be of interest to you when you access and use the Services and other websites or online services.

You may receive advertisements based on information relating to your access to and use of the Services and other websites or online services on any of your devices, as well as on information received from third parties. These companies place or recognize a unique cookie on your browser (including through the use of pixel tags). They also use these technologies, along with information they collect about your online use, to recognize you across the devices you use, such as a mobile phone and a laptop.
